What is a Medical Assistant?

A Medical Assistant is a healthcare professional who plays an important role in providing patient care in our primary care and specialty clinics. They perform a wide variety of administrative and clinical tasks, such as taking vital signs, administering injections, performing lab tests, and recording patient medical history.

What is an Apprenticeship Program?

An apprenticeship combines classroom learning with real-world experience. It is designed to provide individuals with the skills and knowledge needed to succeed in a specific occupation. Apprenticeships are industry-driven and offer a high-quality career pathway where participants earn a wage while they learn and attain a nationally recognized credential. Our six-month program is full-time (40 hours/week) with a Monday-Friday schedule.

How Do I Apply or Receive More Information?

No previous healthcare experience is required, but candidates must have a high school diploma or GED. The application process is online. Selected applicants will be invited to live interviews.
