As a health care leader, Providence Health & Services is committed to providing a safe, healthy and clean environment for all persons, and maintaining a positive community image.

- 1. The use of smokable materials, in any form, is prohibited on Providence property.
- 2. The smokable free policy applies to:
 - a. All caregivers, students, patients, visitors, vendors, and contractors.
 - b. All smokable materials.
 - i) Smokable Materials includes all tobacco and marijuana products. This includes but is not limited to: cigarettes, cigars, pipes, all forms of smokeless tobacco products, electronic cigarettes and other methods of inhaling smoke-like vapors, marijuana and any other material that may be smoke
- 3. Smokable materials waste must be disposed of safely in receptacles. Littering and offensive odors (including the smell of smokable materials) in the workplace will not be tolerated.
